I refer to the Property Seizure and Sale Order issued by the Magistrates Court on 15 May 2018 (copy **enclosed**) and my conversation with Helen of your office today.

I have ascertained that the judgment debtor operates commercial flights from Terminal 1 of Perth Airport on a daily basis. The flight schedule for the next 30 days is:

Flights departing at 2.10am: Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesday, Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays.

Flights departing at 3.50pm: Tuesday, Thursdays, Saturdays and Sundays.

The Malaysia Airlines counters in Terminal 1 open 2 hours before the scheduled departure time and close 1 hour before the scheduled departure time.

The property at the address belonging to the judgment debtor may include:

- aircraft (the judgment debtor appears to operate Boeing 737-800 type aircraft); and
- aircraft supplies; and
- office and counter equipment.
